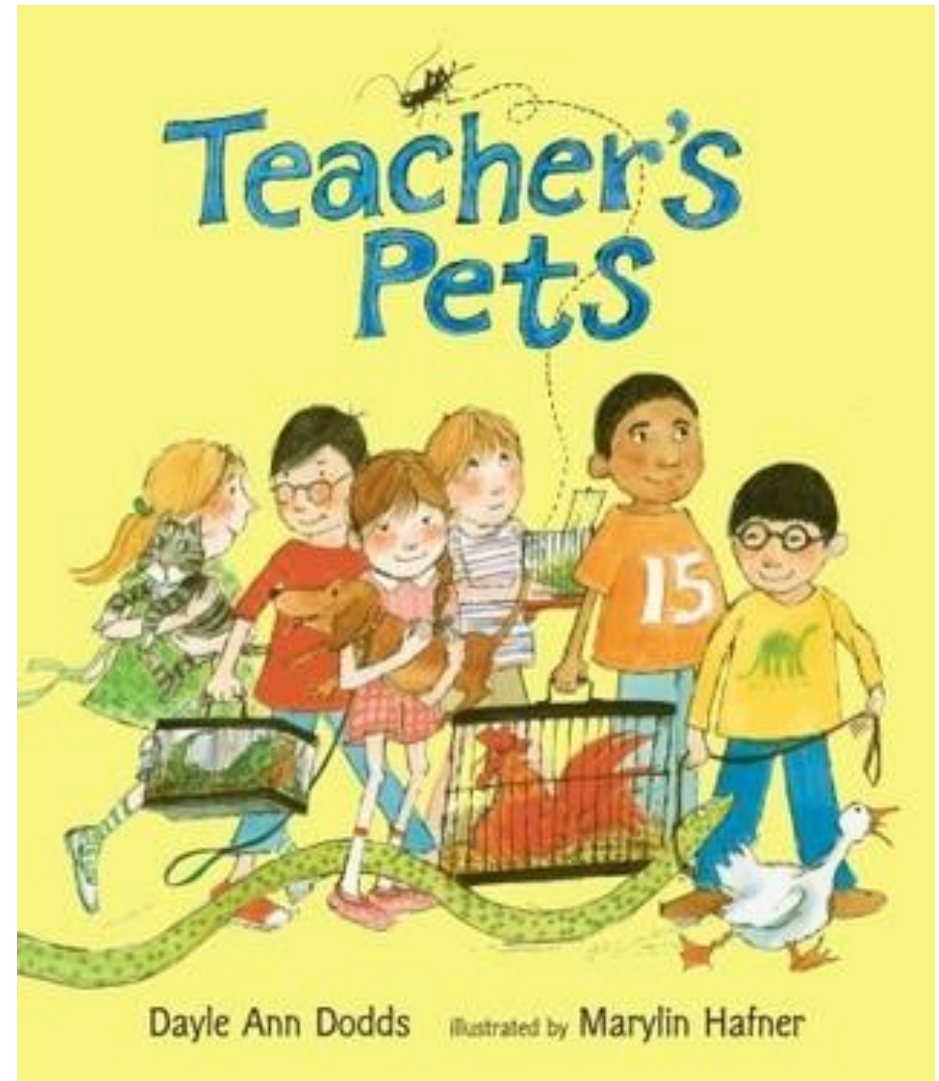


Teacher's Pets

wonderful

What Does It Mean?

If something is wonderful, it is very good.

Sentence:

Pets are wonderful. They make very good friends.

Think About It:

What is something wonderful that happened this week? Tell about it.



noises

What Does It Mean?

Noises are sounds.



Sentence:

Big dogs bark loudly. Small dogs do not make such loud noises.

Think About It:

What are some noises that you might hear outside?

quiet

What Does It Mean?

To be quiet means to make very little or no sound.



Sentence:

A lizard is a very quiet pet. It does not make a sound.

Think About It:

Describe a quiet place that you like to go to.



sprinkled

What Does It Mean?

If you sprinkled something, you scattered small pieces or drops of it.

Sentence:

The fish food was lightly **sprinkled** on top of the water.

Think About It:

What kinds of animals might eat food that has been sprinkled for them?



share

What Does It Mean?

To share means to show to others or to take part in something.

Sentence:

Take pictures of your pets to **share** with your friends.



Think About It:

Do you like to share what you write? How do you feel when you share things in front of the class?

noticed



What Does It Mean?

If you noticed something, you saw it, felt it, or heard it.

Sentence:

This pet rabbit **noticed** or looked carefully, at the carrot held for it to eat.

Think About It:

What have you noticed about the weather today? Describe the weather.

bursting

What Does It Mean?

If something is bursting, it is full and ready to break open suddenly.



Sentence:

Look at this crowded basket. It is **bursting** with puppies.

Think About It:

What might happen if someone is bursting with good news?

suddenly

What Does It Mean?

If something happens suddenly, it happens without warning..

Sentence:

A pet parrot might surprise you if it suddenly says a word.

Think About It:

What is something that can happen suddenly?
